

# Perry County Health Department Homeowner Permit Affidavit

For Single Family Home

For health and safety reasons, the Perry County Health Department is committed to ensuring all plumbing is installed properly in accordance with the Ohio Plumbing Code. The Perry County Health Department Plumbing Code reflects this endeavor by requiring all plumbing work be conducted by a registered plumbing contractor or by the homeowner of a "house that he/she owns and resides."

Homeowners may install their own plumbing if they own the property that is used or will be used as their primary residence. Otherwise, a plumbing contractor who is registered with the Health Department must do the plumbing work. To be eligible to work in Perry County, plumbing contractors must be registered with the Perry County Health Department, carry a \$20,000 bond, and have proof of general liability insurance.

If you wish to install your own plumbing, please sign below and return this form with the completed Residential Plumbing Permit Application along with an isometric drawing of the plumbing system and all applicable fees.

**I understand and will abide by the following statements:**

- I will only use this dwelling as a home for me and my immediate family.
- I will not enter into a contract with an unlicensed contractor. It is understood that I may have advisory assistance from other persons not licensed as contractors with Perry County, provided no contract either verbal or written exists among the parties involved.
- I understand I am responsible for the installation of the plumbing system.
- I understand that I can have assistance with the installation from immediate family members.
- I have attached the permit application, isometrics drawings and the proper fees.
- I will abide by all requirements as set forth in the Ohio Plumbing Code and the Perry County Health Department Plumbing Code.
- I understand I am responsible for installing test equipment and I shall be present for the underground (if needed), rough-in, and final plumbing inspections.
- I understand that plumbing cannot be covered until inspected and approved.
- I understand there is a fee for all re-inspections and for on-site consultations and, therefore, I am responsible for paying said fees prior to the re-inspection or consultation.
- I understand that I may only apply for a permit once every two years for new construction.
