Soil Evaluation Requirements – For Subdivisions and New Lots

Ohio Administrative Code Section 3701-29-08: Subdivisions and New Lots

(B) Any person proposing a subdivision or new lot(s) for review by the board of health shall submit an application and sufficient information to determine compliance with the requirements of this chapter. Minimum information to be submitted or completed for review shall include the following:

(4) A soil evaluation completed in accordance with rule 3701-29-07 of the Administrative Code for each proposed lot;

- 1. All new lots (5.0 acres or less) for review shall have two soil test holes minimum. (Two test holes per new lot) One for leach bed area and one for emergency leach bed area. This will be determined between owner and soil scientist)
- 2. Lots over 5.0 acres will not require a soil test in order to be split, however, soil tests will be required at the time of development of a septic system in the future.
- 3. Lots will not be approved without proper soil tests and reports, submitted with application and fee. If required soil tests are not submitted, lots will be marked as non-developable by our department, until soil reports are completed.
