INTERESTED IN MAKING A DIFFERENCE IN THE HEALTH OF OUR COMMUNITY?

The mission of the Perry County Health Department is to improve public health in Perry County by preventing disease, promoting health and safety, and protecting our environment.

WHAT:

The Perry County District Advisory Council (DAC) is seeking candidates who would like to serve as a member of the Perry County Board of Health. There are two positions that need filled, one of which must be filled by a physician. One term will last 5 years, ending in March 2031 while the physician's term will last until March 2029. The DAC will make appointments with regards to equal representation of all parts of the Health District. The DAC may consider the applicant's place of residence and employment. The provisions for appointments to boards of health are addressed in the Ohio Revised Code.

ABOUT THE BOARD OF HEALTH:

The Perry County Board of Health is the governing body for the district's health department. Responsibilities include establishing public health programs, appointing and employment of staff, financial management and rule-making authority. Board of Health members are appointed by elected officials who serve on the District Advisory Council.

MEETINGS & DUTIES:

The five Board of Health members currently meet on the 2nd Wednesday of every month at 6:00pm. Meetings typically last 2 hours and are held at the Health Department, 2235 State Route 13, New Lexington. Board Members are compensated \$50.00 per meeting.
